

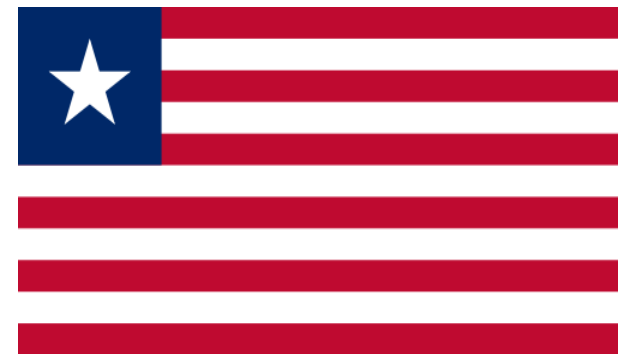
The U.S. National Anthem
